Malcolm Baldrige

Howard Malcolm "Mac" Baldrige Jr. (October 4, 1922–July 25, 1987) was an American businessman. He served as the United States Secretary of Commerce from 1981 until his death in 1987.

His service as Secretary of Commerce was one of the longest in history. Baldrige is said to have been possibly the most colorful Secretary of Commerce and one of the most beloved.

Baldrige was a proponent of quality management as a key to his country's prosperity and long-term strength. He took a personal interest in the legislation that became the Quality Improvement Act of 1987 and helped draft one of the early versions. In recognition of his contributions, Congress named the annual Malcolm Baldrige National Quality Award for product quality in his honor.

Baldrige worked during his boyhood as a ranch hand and earned several awards as a professional team roper on the rodeo circuit. He was inducted into the ProRodeo Hall of Fame in Colorado Springs, Colorado, in 1988, rodeo's highest honor. He maintained a ranch in New Mexico and has relatives living in the state.


